Strike Call To 20,000 Miners Being Held Up

17,000 Still Out, However; Union Leaders in Washington "Explain"

HAZLETON, Pa.—(AP)—A strike call to an additional 20,000 miners in the Pennsylvania anthracite fields was held in abeyance today as insurgent union leaders reached Washington to "explain" to the War Labor Board a seven-day-old wildcat walkout in which 17,000 already are participating.

IRA Chief In Escape

Gets Away From Belfast Prison

BELFAST, Northern Ireland.—Hugh McLeaver, alleged chief of staff of the outlawed Irish Republican Army, escaped today with three other members of the organization from Belfast Prison, where he was serving a fifteen-year sentence for treason.

Flynn Case To Be Aired At Capitol

Public Hearings on Diplomatic Nomination

WASHINGTON.—The Senate Foreign Relations Committee unanimously ordered public hearings today, beginning next week, on proposals against President Roosevelt's nomination of Edward J. Flynn, returning Democratic National Chairman, to be Minister to Australia.

Chairman Connally, Democrat, Texas, said he would confer with Flynn and "other interested parties" to determine a convenient time for the opening of the hearings, which will be conducted by the full 23-member committee. He said the hearings probably would start Wednesday or Thursday.

Flynn must be in Chicago Monday to attend a meeting of the Democratic National Committee to submit his resignation as chairman. Connally told reporters the committee would limit its investigation to charges that could be substantiated by direct testimony of witnesses, barring any hearsay charges against the appointee.
