MASS RAIDS ON MANILA AREA REPORTED

Japs Report
Damage To
Warships

Say 400 Planes
Participated

Waves of American planes
hit Manila and nearby
airfields yesterday and today,
Manila time, doing "slight
damage" to warships, installations,
and shipping. Tokyo
radio and the enemy-controlled
Manila broadcast station
said today.

Four hundred planes blasted the
Philippines capital city, Cavite and
Clark Field yesterday, and 400
more planes were massed
today, said the broadcast.

SAV-35 DOWNED

The enemy claimed that 73
of its aircraft were downed or
damaged by Japanese interceptors
in the two-day period. There has
been no confirmation of the raids
or of the damage.

In heavy raid, the Manila
radio reported, Japanese air-
fields and Cavite, one-time
United States naval base, were
the objects of the attacks.

The Japanese Defense News Agency
said yesterday's raids resulted in
"some damage to our warships,"
but ground facilities were "un-
damaged."

In addition to the Manila and
Cavite areas, the Japanese said
they had bombed Clark Field.

The Japanese communiqué added:

"After about one hour's violent
several hours, our war force shot
down 400 planes held in the sky.
The outcome was uncertain. However,
our side suffered a valuable sacri-
fice of one plane by self-blazing
and four which did not return to
base."

Tokyo claimed the American
planes came from a task force
sent to the Philippines to be
posted by the Japanese.

The Japanese radio said
400 planes participated yesterday
in a western assault on Mindanao
Island, south of Leyte in the
Philippines, and about 28 planes
today. Clark Field, the Clark west
of Manila, was hit for several
days, the Japanese said. P-38s
raided the Negros Islands in the
Philippines.

Fighting in Italy is marked

Japs Slaughtered By American Guns

GENERAL MacARTHUR'S HEADQUARTERS, Philippines—(AP)—(Via Army Radio)—Japanese reinforcements and equipment became a bloody shambles in Limon today when trapped by an American artillery barrage as doughboys moved on the Ormoc road town from three sides.

Observers on Breakneck Ridge
estimated more than 600 dead

rolling into Limon.

ARTILLERY ROARS

the night and today the town was

apparently uninhabited.

correspondent, he was returning

Limon had been knocked out. He added, however, the
Japanese had been compelled to
abandon the town.
