

Three Held In Raleigh Assault

RALEIGH (AP)—Three of four Negro men charged with raping a Raleigh white woman were ordered held without bond yesterday following a preliminary hearing.

City Court Judge Albert Durb found probable cause against the three and ordered them to jail pending trial in Wake Superior Court.

Mrs. Louise Gardner, 37, described the assault, but was unable to point out any of the four defendants as the one who actually raped her.

However, Louis Foster Jr., 28, turned state's evidence and named Milton Ralph Fuller, 34, as the man he saw attack the woman.

The youth said Luke Smith Jr., 19, and John Lee Jackson, 25, were the two men who held her down. Foster's case was not pressed (and prosecuted) with leave.

Mrs. Gardner, arrested for public drunkenness at the time of the incident, said the Negroes raped her in the backyard of a Raleigh home Friday night. She said she went there to buy a pint of whisky.

Tom Dula Story Keeps Going Round

This time tomorrow, reckon where that Tom Dula story will be?

The record "Tom Dooley" was released in October, and word soon came out of Wilkes County that it was based on an old murder near Ferguson.

On Nov. 17, the Journal told the story of Tom Dula and printed pictures of his grave and of the grave of Laura Foster, the girl he was hanged for killing.

In no time at all, all copies of the Nov. 17 paper had been sold, and reports from Wilkes said they were bringing 50 cents a copy up there.

A couple of North Carolina papers borrowed the pictures of Tom Dula's grave.

United Press International bought one of them and circulated it all over the country.

Magazine Uses Photo
Life magazine bought one and circulated it just about everywhere.

Then Capitol Records, the Hollywood outfit which struck gold with the old tune, asked for permission to reprint the Journal article and circulate it among disc jockeys.

Before long, disc jockeys were playing the record and reading the story from coast-to-coast.

Since that started, the Journal has been getting more and more requests for copies that aren't available.

Requests have come from Miami, Fla., from Tacoma, Wash., from Fruitport, Mich., from Key-Saville, Iceland, and from a lot of other places.

Mail Starting Anew?
The mail had just about stopped. Now it may start all over again.

A disc jockey for WROC at Johnston, Pa., read part of the Tom Dula reprint to his listeners, and he's had so many requests for copies that he is reprinting the reprint.

The latest comes from George N. Hassell, editor of the Country-Western Express in Essex, England. He wants to reprint the reprint in his magazine.

And he has a friend who edits a trade journal over in London, and the friend wants to reprint it, too.

Tom Dula's story seems to be getting around.
