**Ballad Hero's Grave Unmarked**

STATESVILLE (AP)—The popular "Ballad of Tom Dooley" tells of the hanging of the Civil War soldier from North Carolina but doesn't complete his tragic story, says an American Legion post here.

"The real tragedy of Tom Dula (correct spelling) is that he lies covered by briars and vines out of view of even rabbit hunters," declares North Iredell Post Commander J. Pierce Van Hoy.

Dula was buried in an unmarked grave in a remote part of Wilkes County in Western North Carolina following his hanging for the slaying of pretty Laura Foster.

The grave, said Van Hoy, "is a disgrace to an American soldier."

And Dula was quite a soldier. "The records show he was a brave and courageous soldier," the Legionnaire said. "So outstanding was his performance that his commanding officer, the late Gov. Zeb Vance, defended him in his battle for life."

Van Hoy's post wants to relocate or restore the grave if it can get permission from Dula's descendants and the approval of "the good people of Wilkes County."

Dula was convicted and put to death in May, 1868, for the 1866 murder in Wilkes County's Happy Valley.

Van Hoy said post members doubt Dula was guilty of the crime, "but out of love and devotion to a Mrs. (Ann) Melton, he took the rap." Mrs. Melton was charged along with Dula. He cleared her in a note just before the hanging.

"We do not in any way condone any evil act he may have performed," said Van Hoy, "but we know he served his country honorably in time of war."

The commander said that in seeking to restore Dula's grave, the post hopes "to bring to the attention of the American public the fact that thousands of our soldiers now lie buried . . . in unmarked graves."
