

Violation of Airspace A Mistake, JFK Admits

WASHINGTON—U.S. President John F. Kennedy today admitted that a U.S. reconnaissance plane violated Soviet airspace Saturday, but said the violation was a mistake and that the President was taking steps to prevent such a recurrence.

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to remind you that military aircraft of a reconnaissance type have violated the frontier of the Soviet Union—a matter over which we have had disputes with you. An example of such a violation was taken place on Oct. 28.

And the President says he is seeing to it that every precaution is taken so it won't happen again.

Khrushchev made his statement in a note to Kennedy, saying that the President's statement was "a very serious and deliberate provocation." The President promptly expressed regret for the violation and said that the United States was taking steps to prevent such a recurrence.

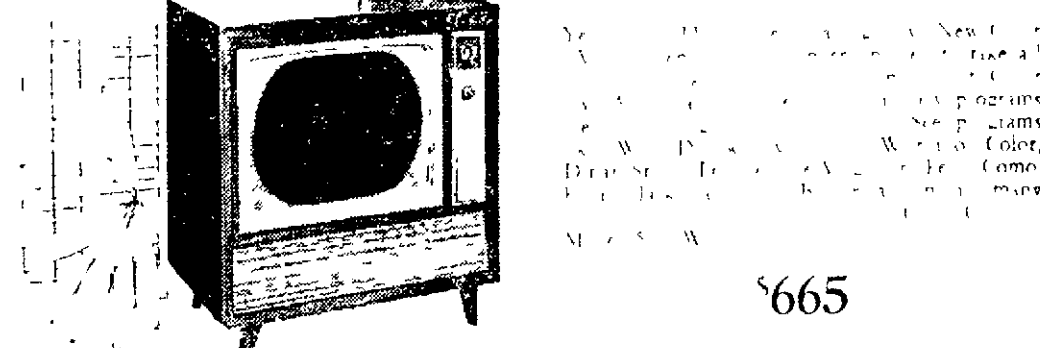
